**By car:** Sarajevo is easy to reach by car. For any advice about the state of the roads, visit [www.bihamk.ba](http://www.bihamk.ba).

**By bus:** There are two bus stations in the town. [Sarajevo Bus Station](#) is located in the city center and provides a connection to almost every town in Bosnia and Herzegovina, as well as to many international destinations. The East Sarajevo Bus Station is located approximately nine kilometers from the center of Sarajevo and connects Sarajevo to cities throughout BiH, Serbia and Montenegro. ## CURRENCY

The Convertible Mark (KM) is the legal instrument of payment in Bosnia and Herzegovina since 1998. The international name for KM is BAM. Each issued banknote has a cash backing in Euros.

Fixed exchange rate of BAM is:

**1 KM = 0,51 € or**

**1 € = 1.96 KM**
